NO AEROSOLS - NO LIQUIDS - NO NEEDLES

NO INHALERS - NO PLASTIC BOTTLES.

Remove all expired and unused pills from their original containers and consolidate into one plastic bag.

Drop off the Bag in the Waterford Police Department Lobby

******Free Deterra Drug Deactivation pouches while supplies last******

If unable to drop items off on April 27, the Police Department's permanent drop-box is available in the lobby Sunday through Saturday from 8 am—6 p.m.
The same disposal restrictions apply.
